There are millions of people struggling to survive in California. Food insecurity and homelessness are just two areas in which there is great need. These things create hopelessness in the people. They directly affect a family's quality of life and a community's stabilization effort of self-sufficiency and community pride. We believe that hopelessness creates disadvantaged, at-risk social economic communities and at-risk rehabilitating mental and physical health issues and concerns. Most local churches and service agencies in the city lack the resources (financial as well as people) to effectively bring about change to these in need. We hope to have a long-term impact by partnering with the area businesses, churches and service agencies to connect those in need with the necessary resources to bring change and ultimately elevate a community.

Our vision is to see this outreach ultimately happen in all southern California counties. In 2015 we started with Orange and Riverside Counties with outreach locations in Anaheim and Moreno Valley. In 2017 the outreach is being held in three counties, Orange, Los Angeles and San Diego. In 2021 due to the pandemic, we had to pause the outreach until 2023. We relaunched SoCal Day of HOPE starting this time with San Diego and will build again to multiple locations in the coming years.
